SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Rules

- 1.1. The races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The S.L.V.Y.R.A. handicap rules.
- 1.3. Yachts shall have their correct sail numbers displayed on their mainsail and genoa in order to be scored, or the Race Committee is advised in writing of the discrepancy before the registration deadline. (The information can be included in the registration form for the race)
- 1.4. The Chilly Bowl is a pursuit race to be sailed with white sails only.

2. Entries

- 2.1. Trophy races such as the Chilly Bowl are held annually at BYC and offer an opportunity for those, who don't normally race, to get out on the water and sail around marks and have some fun. It is also another chance for the hardened racers to go head to head. Trophies and prizes awarded at the Chilly Bowl, represent the long racing history of our Club. These events should be attended by one and all.
- 2.2. The Chilly Bowl is open to all members of clubs associated with SLVYRA.
- 2.3. Yachts should have a SLVYRA handicap. If not, a provisional one may be assigned by the Race Committee.


- 2.4. Yachts may register by returning the attached form to the Beaconsfield Yacht Club administration office, 26 Lakeshore Road, Beaconsfield. The closing time for entry registration is 12:00 p.m. on the day of the race.

3. The Course

- 3.1. The Chilly Bowl is a pursuit race.
3.2. Dropped marks will be used.
3.3. The course shall be as follows:

Start: Between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the Committee Boat on the starboard end and mark 33 on the port end of the line.
Leave the windward mark to port, the gybe mark to port, mark 33 to port, the windward mark to port.
Finish between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the Committee boat at the starboard end of the finishing line and mark 33 at the port end.
Note: In the case of a northerly wind, mark 44 shall be used instead of mark 33.

4. Notices to Competitors

- 4.1. Notices to Competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on at the clubhouse.

5. Changes in Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. Any change in the sailing instructions will be posted on the notice board at BYC at least one hour before the start of the race.

6. Liability

- 6.1. The organizing authority is not responsible for any damage or injury either ashore or afloat, either to persons or yachts, which might result from participating in the race.

7. Schedule

- 7.1. Registration deadline 12:00 p.m.
- 7.2. Skippers' Meeting shall take place at 12:30 p.m.
- 7.3. Start Sequence
 - 7.3.1. Each competitor, shall receive a starting time as per their SLVYRA handicap, which shall follow with the beginning start time at 13:35.

Preparatory	13:31 hours	P code flag up
One Minute	13:34 hours	P code flag down
START	13:35 hours	White flag down

8. Abandoned Races and Time Limits

- 8.1. The Race Committee may shorten or abandon the race. There will be no re-sails.
- 8.2. There will be a time limit of 90 minutes after the first yacht to finish. In order to avoid an unnecessary search, any boat abandoning shall inform either the RC boat on the water or BYC at 514-695-1272 as soon as possible.

9. Protests

- 9.1. Protests must be filled on CYA forms available at the BYC clubhouse in accordance with the Rules, and submitted to the Race Committee within 30 minutes of its arrival on shore. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after the expiry of the 30-minute time limit.

10. Scoring and Prizes

- 10.1. The Chilly Bowl trophy will be awarded based on the first to finish.
- 10.2. The Trophy will be presented at the annual year-end "Awards Night."
- 10.3. Cruising yachts featuring a full keel shall also compete for their own flag, the Heavy Hitters Award.
