NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is the Pointe Claire Yacht Club. This is a non-counter event of the Shark Class.

1 Rules

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 Advertising

Advertising is permitted under ISAF Regulation 20: Advertising Code

3 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all members of the Canadian Shark Class Association.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form in person during the registration or in person with Michael Anderson or Tof Nicoll-Griffith at any time before the event.

3.3 Entry Forms will be available at www.pcyq.qc.ca after June 20th, 2017. Measurement Certificates and safety equipment, for each boat, may be verified at registration.

4 Fees

4.1 The entry fee is \$20. Entry form and payment can only be filled in person at PCYC during the registration. There will be no late penalty or early registration discount.

4.2 PCYC's annual dinner party will be held on Saturday evening. Information and prices will be on the Entry Form. Reservations are required. Call 514-695-2441 to make them. BBQ and Band as well as Canada Day Celebrations will be held at PCYC.

5 Schedule

5.1 Registration Friday June 30th, 4:00- 8:00 PM and Saturday July 1st, 08:00- 09:00 AM in the PCYC clubhouse.

5.2 Competitors' briefing 08:30 AM Sunday July 2nd in the PCYC clubhouse.

5.3 Dates of racing: Saturday July 1st (as part of the PCYC Annual) and Sunday, July 2nd with the Quebec Etchells fleet.

5.4 The number of races scheduled is 7.

5.5 The scheduled time for the warning for the first race Saturday, July 1st, is 11:00 AM.

5.6 The scheduled time for the warning for the first race on Sunday July 2nd, will be 10:00 AM.

5.7 No warning signal will be displayed after 14:00 PM Sunday July 2nd.

5.8 The awards ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race on Sunday.

6 Venue

Racing will take place on Lac Saint-Louis.

7 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. GNS Sailing Instructions apply for Saturday only. Separate SI's will apply for Sunday. GNS instructions can be found at www.gnsracing.com

8 The Course

The course to be sailed will be windward – leeward type.

9 Scoring

9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9.3 When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 Launch and Haul Out

All boats must be in the water by 09:30 AM Saturday July 1st and shall not be hauled during the regatta except with the prior permission of the Race Committee

11 Prizes

Quebec Championship plaque will be awarded.

Keeper prizes will be awarded for first through fifth place.

12 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per event or equivalent.
